From IT Management to Executive Impact

Most IT leaders do not fail because they lack technical expertise.

How to Use This Playbook

Three Ways to Engage

PATH 1: The Full Transformation (90 Days)

Read all six steps sequentially. Complete every Readiness Check. Execute every Action Plan. This is the comprehensive path for those committed to total transformation.

Timeline: 2-3 weeks per chapter = 12-18 weeks total

Best for: New CIOs, major career transitions, those with significant gaps

PATH 2: The Targeted Fix (2-4 Weeks)

Use the Readiness Checks in each chapter to identify your biggest weakness. Jump to that chapter. Execute that Action Plan. Reassess. Repeat.

Timeline: 2-3 weeks per focused area

Best for: Experienced leaders with specific gaps

PATH 3: The Crisis Response (72 Hours)

You have a board presentation in 3 days. A major IT investment needs CFO approval. You're being evaluated for promotion. Jump to the relevant chapter, read the mini-cases, use the frameworks.

Timeline: Immediate

Best for: Urgent situations requiring immediate application

How Each Chapter Works

Every chapter follows the same structure:

1. Theory (Why This Matters) — 15-20 pages of frameworks and principles
2. Practice (How to Apply) — Step-by-step implementation guidance
3. Reality (What Actually Happened) — 2 mini-cases with real metrics
4. Assessment (Where Are You?) — Executive Readiness Check
5. Execution (What to Do Monday) — 2-3 week Action Plan with specific tasks

Estimated time per chapter: 2-3 hours to read, 2-3 weeks to execute
